

Ambulatory Sizing	Pre-Form Collar	Position Back	Cleaning/Drying
 Place arms down along side. Place sizing guide next to head with the card resting on the highest point of the shoulder. Draw an imaginary line from chin bottom to sizing guide and select collar size. 	 Roll collar front panel inward. Roll up back panel. 	 Fold Velcro loop strap over foam pad. Center the back panel under crevice of neck. Velcro straps should be centered between the ear and the top of the shoulder muscle. 	 Cleaning: Hand wash pads with mild soap and warm water. Do not machine wash or use bleach. Rinse thoroughly. The plastic shell of the collar may be wiped with mild soap and water. Rinse and towel dry before re-attaching pads. Drying: Squeeze out the excess water by pressing pads with a towel. Allow to completely air dry by laying on a towel. Do not use heat to dry. Use replacement pads during drying time. Additional replacement pads are available from your Health Care Professional.
 Position Front Position chin piece directly under chin (generally, the chin should not extend beyond the edge of the plastic). Push sides of front panel up over shou- lder muscles and around neck. 	Attach Front Hold firmly with one hand. Place back panel under reevice of neck until panel is centered under neck and attach both sides to front while keeping the back panel centered.	 Proper Size & Fit Patients chin should be flush with end of collar chin piece. Trach opening should not be touching airway (if it does, refit with next taller size collar). Back panel should be centered (from the front, the back Velcro straps should be sym- metrical).
